Most wireless-enabled devices are now pre-configured to allow quick and easy access to open Wi-Fi networks such as the one at St Pancras International.

Once you are connected and logged in to the free network you will enjoy seamless internet access across almost all areas of St Pancras.

This leaflet offers help if you experience issues or have any queries as you log on to our network.

## For all Windows users

The instructions are based around the Windows XP Operating System. Other operating systems are similar in their set up and use. Please ensure your device is enabled for wireless access and that this option is activated.

### Step 1 – Confirming your SSID settings:

- a) Click 'Start'.
- b) Go to 'Control Panel'.
- c) Go to 'Network and Internet Connections'.
- d) Choose 'Network Connections'.
- e) Highlight and right-click on your Wireless Network Connection. Choose 'Properties' from the menu.
- f) Highlight the 'Wireless Network' tab. (If you use another application to manage wireless networks, then this tab would not be displayed, use that application instead and check for the available wireless connections and you may not need to do all of the following steps to connect).
- g) The network SSID 'StPancras WiFi' should be visible under the 'Available networks' section provided that you are in the coverage area. Select and double click on this option and a new window will popup. Ensure that the Data encryption (WEP enabled) option is not selected in this window, as this is an open network designed for public access and click 'Ok'.
- h) Now click the 'Advanced' button and in the window that pops up, ensure that 'Access point only (infrastructure) networks only' is selected and click 'Close'.

### Step 2 – Obtain an IP Address:

- a) Click on the 'General' tab in the same window. Highlight the 'Internet Protocol TCP/IP' option and click on 'Properties'.
- b) Select 'Obtain an IP address automatically' and 'Obtain DNS server address automatically' and click OK to confirm.

### Step 3 – Configuring Microsoft Internet Explorer

- a) Open your browser and go to the 'Tools' menu.
- b) Select 'Internet Options' and the tab 'Connections'.
- c) Under 'LAN Settings' open the window for 'Local Area Network LAN) settings'.

### Ensure that the following options are not selected:

- 1 'Automatically detect settings'.
- 2 'Use automatic configuration script'.
- 3 'Use a proxy server for your LAN'.

Click OK to confirm.

**After you have carried out these changes you may need to reboot your device but this is usually not required.**

If you experience a fault when trying to connect to the St Pancras International WiFi please report it to one of our station staff.

The network SSID 'StPancras WiFi' should be visible under the 'Available networks' section provided that you are in the coverage area N.B. there may be multiple occurrences of 'StPancras WiFi', it does not matter which one you select. Select and double click on this option and a new window will popup. Ensure that the Data encryption (WEP enabled) option is not selected in this window, as this is an open network designed for public access and click 'Ok'.

## For all Mac users:

Simply compare the settings on your laptop with the configurations below in order to use the St Pancras Wireless network.

Instructions are based on Mac OS X Operating System (version 10). To turn on Wireless LAN on your laptop:

- a) Click on "Turn Airport" in the toolbar.
- b) Click on "Turn Airport On".
- c) Click on 'Airport' icon again and select 'StPancras WiFi' from the list of available networks (You have to be inside the coverage area to see this).
- d) Select 'Open Internet Connect...' option and you will see that you are now connected.

## For all PDA Users:

### Before you start

- a) Click 'Start'
- b) Go to 'Settings'
- c) Select 'Connections' tab
- d) Choose 'Network cards'
- e) From the list of available networks, choose SSID 'StPancras WiFi' and click OK
- f) Now you will be connected to the network
